

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Rayyan was evaluated due to **Information Processing Delays, Developmental Delays, and hyperlexia closer to hyperlexia 2**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. This evaluation is not a definitive diagnosis. Further analysis and proactive interventions are essential to optimize his developmental outcomes.

### Recommended Plan:

#### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- A **non-chemical protocol** for **information processing delays**.
- Conduct this protocol for **4 months**, followed by an **in-person reevaluation**.
- Establish a **baseline** to monitor progress and adjust the intervention plan accordingly.

#### 2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):

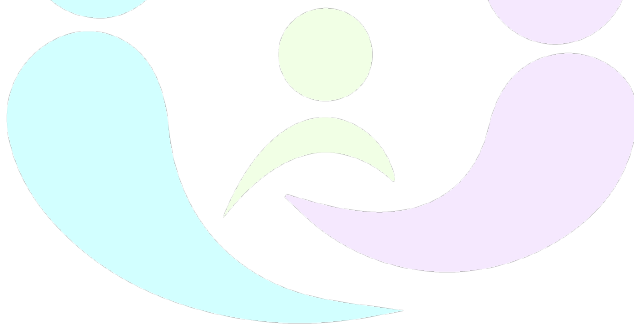

### 3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Immediate and Ongoing):** Focuses on enhancing neural connections, supporting learning, and reducing developmental gaps.
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy (2 sessions each per week):**
  - **Speech Therapy (2ST):** Enhances communication and language processing.
  - **Occupational Therapy (2OT):** Promotes independence in daily activities and sensory integration.


