Overview

Faisal Mohammad Al Dosari visited EICADD Center Ajman for a developmental progress assessment. During the evaluation, the child demonstrated **information processing delays and global developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties and speech delays**.

These findings are consistent with developmental regulation challenges rather than classical autism. Based on the current assessment, **the child does not score as a case of autism**.

Further analysis is recommended in order to identify the underlying biological and developmental causes and to tailor the most effective intervention plan. Continued follow-up is essential to monitor progress and guide targeted support.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for **4 months**, followed by a reassessment
- Reevaluate the developmental plan and establish a **new baseline**
- Continue the structured intervention plan without interruption
- Preferably, reassessment should be done **in person**

2) Recommended Therapy (After Determining the Causes)

- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy – Intensive Program**
 - To begin **as soon as possible**
 - Preferably start the intensive phase **after 3 months**, once foundational causes are clarified

Notes on External Testing

All recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with **accredited international laboratories**. These tests are **external** and **not performed directly through our centers**.

They are **recommendations, not obligations**, aimed at providing deeper insight into a child's developmental profile.
