

# **Overview:**

Fahad Mohammed Alfardan visited our center for a developmental evaluation due to concerns regarding learning and cognitive performance. The assessment revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties**. Importantly, the child does not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder but presents with neurodevelopmental challenges that require further exploration and support.

These challenges may be linked to physiological or biochemical factors and should be thoroughly assessed to tailor an effective intervention plan.

#### **Recommended Plan:**



- o Apply the protocol over 4 months.
- Conduct an in-person reevaluation to establish a detailed developmental and cognitive baseline.
- o Adjust the intervention plan as needed based on progress.

# 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- Note: Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information.
   These tests are suggestions and not obligatory. They are performed externally and not through our center directly.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
  - Begin Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (2–3 sessions per week) immediately to support information processing and cognitive performance.

### Follow-Up Plan:

 A follow-up assessment is recommended after 4 months to monitor progress and update the protocol accordingly.
