Overview

Naif visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The child has **improved on the first protocol**, indicating **high potential for further developmental progress**. Previous external analyses conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)** identified **variants affecting development**, contributing to **acquired features of autism**. However, Naif **does not score as a case of autism**, and his profile aligns more closely with **developmental delays** rather than autism spectrum disorder.

The improvement observed during the intervention confirms strong responsiveness to therapy, and with continued support, Naif is expected to show further progress. This report represents his current developmental status and is not a final diagnosis.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for **4 months**, followed by reevaluation **preferably in person**.
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a clear **baseline** during the next appointment.
- Complete all therapy sessions as part of the intervention plan.

2. Main Recommended Analysis (Through Neurazon – Canada)

These analyses are conducted through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with international accredited laboratories. These tests are external, optional, and not performed directly through EICADD Center.

3. Recommended Therapy

A. Rehabilitation Therapy

- **Plasticity Therapy / Occupational Therapy (OT):**
Intensive blocks of **1–2 weeks every month for 4 months**, with the possibility of increasing intensity if appropriate.
This therapy supports cognitive development, processing abilities, communication, and behavioural regulation.

Notes on External Testing

All recommended analyses above are conducted **exclusively through Neurazon (Canada)**.

These are **recommendations**, not mandatory, and are not performed directly through our center.

Conclusion

This assessment is **not a final diagnosis** but a developmental evaluation based on current findings. Naif has shown strong improvement and exhibits **high potential for further progress**. With consistent therapy and adherence to the intervention plan, additional developmental advances are expected.


