Overview

Azzan Faisal Alzadjali was evaluated at EICADD Center Ajman for a developmental progress assessment. The child demonstrates **information processing delays and global developmental delays**, which are contributing to **learning difficulties**, **delayed speech development**, and **overall developmental delay**.

These challenges have resulted in acquired features of autism, but based on the current evaluation, the child does not meet the criteria for a diagnosis of autism. The findings point toward a developmental pattern driven by regulatory and processing delays rather than classical autism.

Further analysis is necessary to identify underlying biological and physiological factors contributing to the child's developmental profile. Continued monitoring and structured intervention are essential to support improvement.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for 4 months, followed by a full reassessment
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a **new developmental baseline**
- Continue with the current intervention plan consistently
- Preferably, reassessment should be conducted in person





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- 2) Recommended Therapy (After Determining the Causes)
 - Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy Intensive Program
 - o To begin in **later stages**, once the underlying causes are clarified through the recommended analyses
 - Will target information processing, cognitive development, and overall neurodevelopmental regulation

Notes on External Testing

All recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon** (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These tests are external and are not conducted directly through our centers.

They are **recommendations**, **not obligations**, and are intended to provide deeper insights into the child's biological and developmental profile. Parents should refer to Neurazon's official documentation for full information regarding these external analyses.

This assessment is **not a final diagnosis** but a developmental evaluation based on current observations. The child is open to improvement, and the findings may evolve with intervention and progress.
