Overview

Aslan Anas Mami visited **Ostathna Center – Jordan** for a developmental progress assessment.

The evaluation revealed that **Aslan presents with information-processing delays and developmental delays leading to hyperlexia between Type 2 and Type 3, currently closer to Hyperlexia Type 3 but not fully there yet.**

This finding highlights the importance of **early and consistent intervention** to address both his language and cognitive processing needs.

Further **analyses are recommended** to explore the underlying biomedical and neurological factors contributing to his developmental profile.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the **development protocol for 4 months.**
- **Reevaluate after 4 months**, preferably in person, to establish a new baseline and adjust the plan accordingly.
- Maintain ongoing **home-based reinforcement** to strengthen therapy gains.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

Note: The above tests are conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified international laboratories.

These tests are **recommendations only and not obligatory**, and are **not conducted directly at Ostathna Center – Jordan**.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Occupational Therapy – Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** 2 sessions per week to support cognitive and sensory-motor development.

Conclusion

Aslan's developmental profile reflects a **unique pattern of hyperlexia (between Type 2 and 3)**, requiring targeted intervention to enhance language comprehension, information processing, and social-adaptive functioning.

A combined approach of **developmental protocol, intensive occupational therapy focusing on neuroplasticity, and further biomedical analyses** is expected to foster continued improvement in cognitive and language domains.
