Overview

Abdulla attended our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. These patterns reflect challenges in communication, behavior regulation, and adaptive developmental skills.

The child demonstrates potential for improvement with early and structured intervention. Further analysis is recommended to assist in personalizing the developmental plan and addressing underlying contributing factors.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured development protocol for **4 months**
- Reevaluate afterward, preferably in person
- Establish a developmental baseline at next assessment
- Continue the intervention plan consistently

2) Main Recommended Analyses

(Conducted externally through Neurazon – Canada)

3) Recommended Therapy

- Continue **Speech Therapy** and **Occupational Therapy**
- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** in later stages (when ready)

Conclusion

Abdulla presents with information processing and developmental delays leading to acquired features of autism. With timely intervention and consistent developmental support, the child has favorable potential for improvement. Continued monitoring and structured therapy are recommended.

This report represents a developmental assessment and not a final diagnosis. Ongoing reassessment is essential.


