Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Qusai Ahmed Yacoub visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays and developmental delays** that have led to **speech and motor delays**. These challenges appear to be associated with **epileptic developmental delays**, resulting in **regressive brain development** affecting cognitive and motor pathways.

The findings suggest that the child's developmental and neurological function has been impacted over time, and a **comprehensive analysis** is recommended to better understand the underlying biochemical and neurological causes contributing to these difficulties.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with the individualized **development protocol** for a period of **4 months**, followed by a detailed re-evaluation (preferably in person).
- Reassess progress and establish a clear baseline for future comparison.
- Maintain continuous monitoring and gradual implementation of the intervention plan.

2) Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada)

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. 3) Recommended Therapy (after determining the causes)

- **Neuroplasticity Therapy (Intensive):** To be introduced in later stages once the child's neurological readiness and biochemical stability improve.
- **Supportive rehabilitation and monitoring** to continue during the initial phase of intervention.
