### Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

#### Overview

Zaid visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. During the evaluation, he exhibited **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays**, which are contributing to **acquired features of autism** and **learning disabilities**.

A significant clinical indicator is that **his brother also experiences learning difficulties**, which strongly suggests a **biological and hereditary contributing cause** rather than purely environmental factors.

The child does **not score as a case of classical autism**, and his profile is consistent with developmental and cognitive delays leading to acquired autistic features. Further analysis is required to understand the underlying biological mechanisms and guide a more targeted intervention.

#### Recommended Plan

##### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement the protocol for **4 months**, after which the child should undergo a follow-up reassessment, preferably **in person**.
- Reevaluate the developmental plan and establish a clear **baseline** for improvement.
- Continue with the structured **intervention plan** already initiated.

## 2) Recommended Tests (External – Through Neurazon Canada)

All recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories.

These tests are **external, optional, and not performed directly through our center.**

## 3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes

- **Plasticity rehabilitation therapy**, intensive schedule, to begin as soon as possible. Frequency and structure will be adjusted following the detailed analyses to ensure targeted neuroplasticity stimulation.

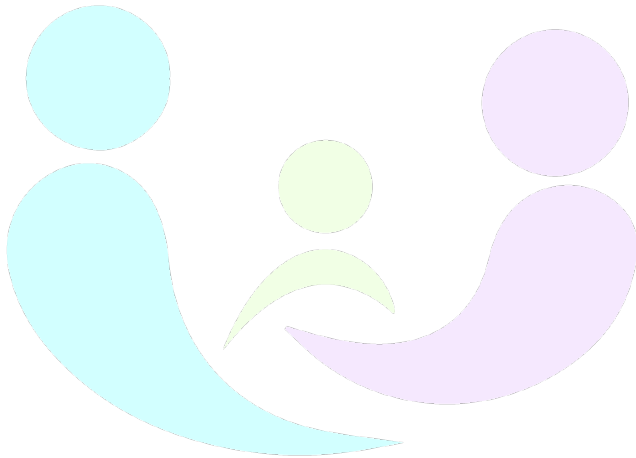
