Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Dahab attended our center for a developmental progress screening. The assessment shows **slight information processing delays and mild attention difficulties**, however the child currently demonstrates **typical developmental progression overall**.

At this stage, the findings suggest that development is within expected ranges for age, and there are **no indications of autism or significant developmental disorders**. Continued monitoring is recommended to ensure steady growth in communication, cognitive, and behavioral domains.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue supportive developmental stimulation at home
- Reassessment in **4 months**, preferably in person
- Update developmental baseline and ensure continued age-appropriate progress

2) Recommended Analyses Through Neurazon (Canada)

At this stage, **no further analyses are required**.

Future testing may be recommended only if developmental concerns arise during follow-ups.

3) Recommended Therapy

- No therapy is required at this time
- Continue natural learning, play-based engagement, and social exposure

Notes

Parents are encouraged to continue:

- Daily structured play and interaction
- Reading and language-enriching activities
- Exposure to varied learning and social environments

Notes on External Testing

The recommended analyses mentioned in other reports are **not required at this time**. Any future recommendations for Neurazon testing would be based on follow-up assessment findings.

Disclaimer

This evaluation is **not a final diagnosis**, but a developmental assessment based on current observations. The child is expected to continue improving with age and natural stimulation. This report is **valid for 4 months** from the assessment date, after which a follow-up evaluation is recommended to confirm continued progress.
