Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdullah Abdulaziz Al Altwirji visited our center for a developmental evaluation. The child presents with **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have led to **hyperlexia patterns closer to Hyperlexia Type 2**, though he has not fully developed this type yet. With appropriate intervention, there is a strong possibility of transitioning towards **Hyperlexia Type 3**, indicating a promising prognosis. A comprehensive intervention plan and further assessment are necessary.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Continue the protocol for **4 months**, followed by in-person reassessment.
 - o Establish a developmental baseline during the reevaluation.
 - o Continue tailored intervention strategies accordingly.
- 2. Recommended Analyses (via Neurazon Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are done not done at EICADD.
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - o Continue therapy with local specialists in the child's home area.
 - Begin neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy as soon as possible, at an intensive frequency, to support language, reading comprehension, and executive functioning skills.
