

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Aldhaby was assessed at our center for developmental evaluation. The findings indicate **developmental delays** and **information processing delays**, with signs pointing toward a **hyperlexic profile**, closer to **Hyperlexia Type 2**, though not fully meeting the criteria. These characteristics have resulted in **acquired features of high-functioning autism**, but not classical autism. The child is **open to improvement**, and further follow-up and intervention are strongly recommended.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol:

- Initiate the **information processing development protocol**.
- Implement for a duration of **4 months**, followed by **reevaluation** (preferably in person).
- Reassess baseline and progress to determine necessary adjustments.
- Continue intervention based on observed outcomes.

Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

Note: These tests are optional and done through **Neurazon (Canada)**. They are **not mandatory** and **not conducted directly** through our center. They are research-guided suggestions based on our protocol.

Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - Suitable for **later stages** once readiness is established.
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy:**
 - Should be **continued at home** with qualified professionals.

Conclusion:

This report represents a **developmental assessment**, not a final diagnosis. Aldhaby has **strong potential for improvement**, and future assessments may reflect changes as intervention proceeds. Timely and consistent therapy, combined with further analysis, will help refine the support plan.
