Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Yaman Qatouni was reassessed following the initial phase of intervention and has shown notable improvement. Despite this progress, the child continues to exhibit signs of information processing delays and developmental delays. Genetic variants previously identified appear to contribute to acquired features of autism. Ongoing support and targeted assessment are needed to build on this improvement and determine the next steps for intervention.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Continue with a structured, non-medicinal protocol focused on enhancing cognitive processing.
 - Maintain this plan for 4–6 months.
 - Reevaluate the child preferably in person at the end of this period to monitor progress.
 - Establish a developmental baseline during reassessment to inform future intervention.
- 2. Main Recommended Analysis for Next Evaluation (through Neurazon Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and asssessment. These tests are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Main Recommended Therapy:
 - o Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:
 - Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week (intensive if possible).
 - To begin immediately to support further developmental and neurological improvement.
