Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Amir Mustafa was assessed at our center and presented with signs of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. However, the child does **not score as a true case of autism**. These findings suggest that his developmental challenges are modifiable, and the child requires further analysis and continued intervention.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing
- Implement for 4 months
- Reevaluate the child, preferably in person
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a developmental baseline
- Continue with the appropriate intervention plan
- 2. Recommended Tests for Later Stages (after 2 months):
- Recommended through Canada: Neuronal Growth Factors Analysis Neurazon (Canada)

A more detailed analysis of the absorption

Sample: Hair

Turnaround: 2 months business days Frequency: Repeated every 6–12 months

- 2–3 sessions of Mitotherapy (LT) per week
