

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 06-07-2025

Child's Name: Sarah Mohammed H Al Ghamdi

Date of Birth: 25-04-2013

Overview:

Sarah Mohammed H Al Ghamdi was assessed at our center and demonstrated information processing delays along with signs of regressive cognitive developmental delays. These issues have contributed to acquired features of autism. The regression in cognitive development is of concern and indicates the need for deeper investigation to identify potential contributing biological or neurological factors. Prompt and ongoing intervention is essential to support her recovery and progress.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Begin a structured developmental intervention tailored to Sarah's specific processing challenges.
- Continue this plan for a period of 4 months.
- Reevaluate her in person at the end of this period to monitor progress and update the treatment strategy.
- Establish a cognitive and developmental baseline during the next evaluation to guide future planning.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- Please refer to their report and assessment. These tests are not done at EICADD.

3. Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - To be considered in later stages, following reassessment after the initial 4-month protocol.
 - The decision to initiate neuroplasticity rehabilitation will depend on Sarah's readiness and response to the current plan.

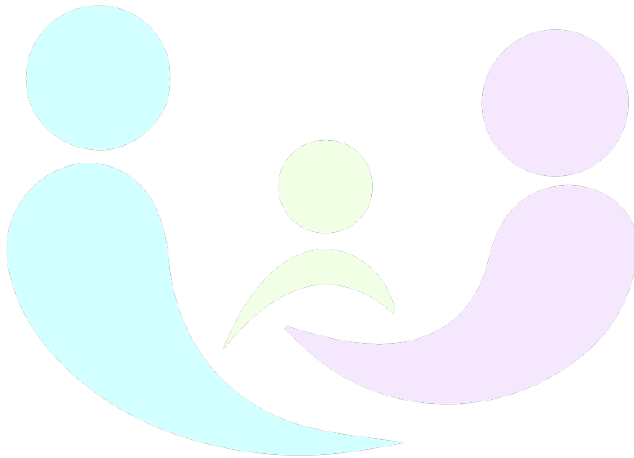

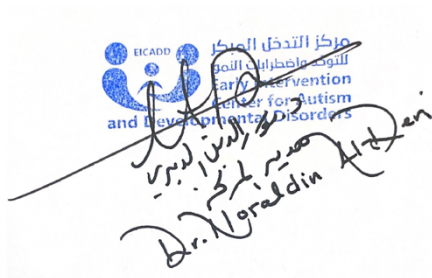
