Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Majd Fayez Al Hamra visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicated **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism and hyperlexia-like features**. These findings suggest challenges in integrating and interpreting information efficiently, leading to atypical learning and communication patterns. Further analysis is recommended to better understand the underlying biomedical and neurodevelopmental contributors.

Recommended Plan:



1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement the individualized protocol for **4 months**, followed by an in-person re-evaluation.
- Establish a developmental and behavioral baseline to measure progress.
- Continue with the structured **intervention plan** based on the reassessment outcome.

2) Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada)

• Please refer to external report and assessment provided by them. These analyses are not done at EICADD.

3) Recommended Therapy (after determining the causes)

• Neuroplasticity Therapy (intensive): To be introduced in later stages once the child is ready.

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• Rehabilitation Therapy and School Integration: Continue consistent developmental therapy and maintain a supportive educational setting.

Notes on External Testing:

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (**Canada**), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. Please refer to the plan provided by Neurazon for further information. These tests are **external**and **not performed directly through our center**. They are **recommendations**, not obligations, designed to support a deeper understanding of the child's developmental profile.
