



Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 30-04-2025

Child's Name: Aleen Nsairat

Date of Birth: 30-06-2021

Assessment Summary:

Aleen was assessed in person at our center on **30-04-2025**. The child has shown **improvement on the first step of the protocol**. During the evaluation, Aleen presented with **information processing delays, intellectual developmental delays, and motor developmental delays**, which appear to be related to a **genetic variant previously identified**. These findings indicate the need for continued support and more structured follow-up to further guide the intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Non-Medicinal Protocol:

- Continue with the structured intervention protocol for **information processing support**
- Duration: **4-6 months**, followed by in-person reevaluation
- A baseline should be reaffirmed and tracked throughout the therapy

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2. Main Recommended Analysis:

- No additional tests required at this stage
- Further testing **may be needed depending on the outcome** of the next evaluation

3. Recommended Therapy:

- **Mitotherapy (light-based therapy):**
 - **1-2 sessions per week**, as tolerated and based on therapeutic response






Conclusion:
