

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Follow-Up Assessment

Overview:

This is the second developmental assessment for Masah at our center. The child has shown **notable improvement** since the initial intervention and protocols. However, continued monitoring and follow-up are essential to ensure sustained developmental progress. Please refer to the **previous developmental report** and the **Neurazon Precision Health Analysis report** for more details on the initial findings and recommendations.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Reevaluation and Monitoring:**

- Reevaluation is recommended every **4 months** to monitor progress and adjust the intervention protocol if needed.

2. **Regular Testing (Please refer to their report and assessment- Not Done at EICADD):**

Next evaluation with Neurazon according to their evaluation:

○ **Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis – Neurazon (Canada)**

- Sample: Hair
- Turnaround: ~2 months (business days)
- Frequency: Every 6–12 months

○ **Functional Urine Pathway Analysis – Neurazon (Canada)**

- Sample: Urine
- Turnaround: ~3 months (business days)
- Frequency: Every 6–12 months

3. **Recommended Therapy:**

○ **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**

- Intensive sessions recommended during each follow-up phase for optimal developmental support
