Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Tamim visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates that he presents with **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have led to **hyperlexia-like features closer to Hyperlexia Type 2**. These findings reflect strong visual-verbal memory skills with advanced word-recognition tendency, paired with delays in comprehension, processing, and social-communication development.

The child does not meet the criteria for autism, but rather falls under developmental delay with hyperlexia-related traits. The developmental pattern suggests brain processing delays rather than a classical autism profile. With continued intervention, there remains positive potential for improvement.

Further analysis is required to better understand the underlying biological and developmental contributors and to continue guiding targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured development protocol for **4 months**, followed by re-evaluation (preferably in person)
- Establish a clear developmental baseline at the next review
- Continue with the individualized intervention plan

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

3) Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity rehabilitation therapy** intensive protocol to support processing and comprehension
- Speech & Occupational Therapy continue consistently
 - o Focus on processing speed, language comprehension, and executive skills
 - o Activities to strengthen motor coordination and writing organization
