

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 22-06-2025

Child's Name: Taleen-Hussam Alkhateeb

Overview:

Taleen was assessed at our center following concerns related to focus, behavior, and academic performance. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** alongside **ADHD-like patterns**. However, based on current observations, the child **does not meet the full criteria for ADHD**. These patterns appear to stem from underlying processing inefficiencies, and further analysis is needed to explore the biological or neurological basis for these challenges.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Begin a focused developmental protocol targeting cognitive and processing delays for **4 months**.
- A **reassessment is advised after 4 months**, preferably in person.
- Establish a functional baseline and adjust the plan accordingly.

2. Recommended Tests (Based on Next Evaluation):

Please refer to their report. These tests are conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada). They are optional and recommended based on further evaluation.

3. Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):** 2–3 sessions per week
- **Neuroplasticity Therapy (UAE):** Intensive, customized intervention to support cognitive and attentional improvement

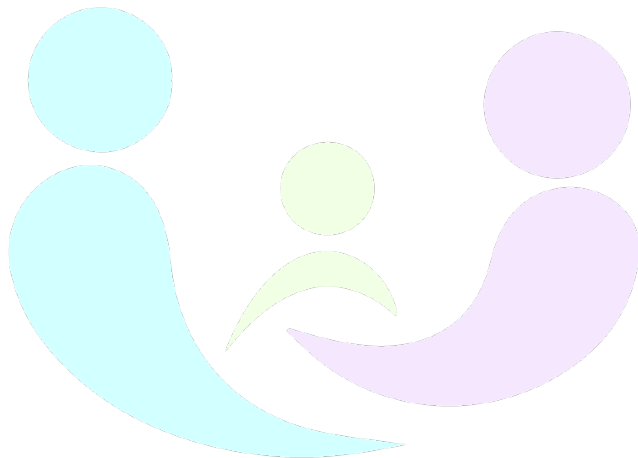
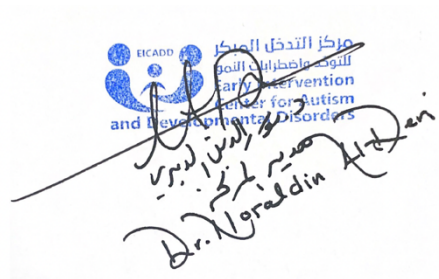
