Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Ali Hasan returned for follow-up evaluation after undergoing the initial developmental intervention protocol. He has shown **significant improvement**, demonstrating positive responses to the initial plan. However, the child continues to exhibit **information processing delays and broader developmental delays**, which are linked to **genetic variants identified in prior analyses**.

These challenges remain manageable and show good potential for further improvement through continued tailored intervention and guided therapy.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Developmental Protocol for Information Processing
 - o Continue with a structured, non-chemical developmental protocol over the next 4 months.
 - o Child should be reassessed after 4 months, preferably in person, to evaluate progress.
 - Establish a new developmental baseline and adjust the plan according to observed improvements.
- Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada): Please refer to plan provided by neurazon for further information. Please note that these are recommendations and not obligatory and are not done trough our centers directly.

Conclusion:

Ali Hasan is making measurable progress and has shown responsiveness to personalized intervention. Continued focus on enhancing information processing and correcting underlying physiological imbalances will be essential. This is not a final medical diagnosis but a developmental analysis, and the child should be **reassessed regularly** to guide and refine future treatment strategies.
