

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 24-06-2025

Child's Name: Yousef-Ali Seadan

Date of Birth: 20-06-2023

Overview:

Yousef was assessed at our center and showed **great improvement** following the first stage of intervention. He presents with **information processing delays** linked to **enzymatic and genetic variants**, which have resulted in **acquired features of autism**. However, these features are not indicative of true autism, but rather stem from **developmental delays**. Continued progress and evaluation are necessary.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing:

- Continue the current protocol for **4–6 months**, then reevaluate the child (preferably in person)
- Reevaluate the intervention plan and establish a developmental baseline
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan based on results

2. Main Recommended Analysis:

- Further testing will be determined based on the outcome of the next evaluation

3. Recommended Therapy:

- **Mitotherapy (Light Therapy):** 2 sessions per week
- **Speech Therapy (ST):** 2 sessions per week
- **Occupational Therapy (OT):** 2 sessions per week

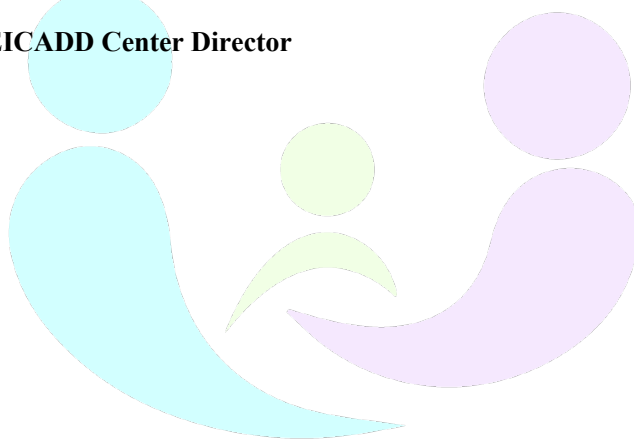
