

**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 14-08-2025

**Child's Name:** Karam Ammar Nerabieh

**Date of Birth:** 07-03-2015

**Overview:**

Karam Ammar Nerabieh visited our center for a developmental assessment. The evaluation indicated **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to an **ADHD/ADD phenotype** and **acquired features of autism**. The child also presents with **Hyperlexia Type 2** features. The primary concern at this stage is the developmental delays, and further assessment is necessary to refine the intervention strategy.

**Recommended Plan:**

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing**
  - Implement for 4 months, followed by an in-person reassessment.
  - Reevaluate the plan and establish a developmental baseline.
  - Continue with the intervention plan based on observed progress.
2. **Recommended Tests (through Neurazon, Canada):**
  - **Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
  - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** 2–3 sessions per week to begin as soon as possible.

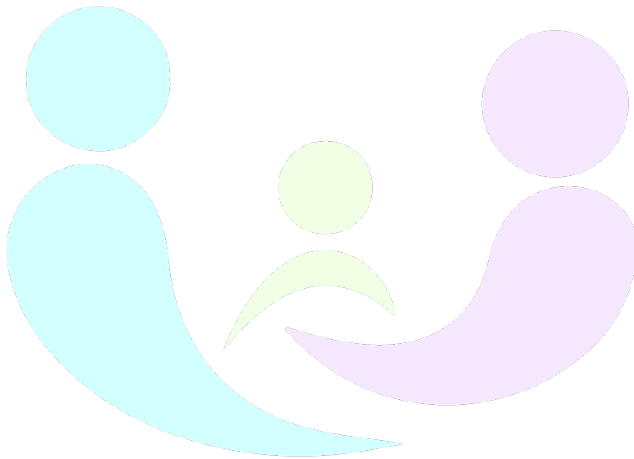
