

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

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### Overview:

Adam was assessed online for developmental progress. The evaluation indicated **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which have resulted in **acquired features of autism**. However, Adam does **not score as a case of autism**.

Due to the remote nature of this assessment, in-person evaluation is strongly recommended in the future to establish a more comprehensive baseline.

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### Recommended Plan:

#### 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue structured development intervention focused on processing and comprehension.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
- Establish a baseline at that stage and refine the plan accordingly.
- Maintain intervention continuity for optimal progress.

#### 2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

#### 3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**


