Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Shaban Omar Aleshebat was assessed at our center on May 24th, 2025. The assessment revealed the presence of **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. These delays impact the child's ability to understand, respond to, and process stimuli appropriately in real-time settings, affecting cognitive, emotional, and social functioning.

Further medical and neurological analysis is recommended to identify potential underlying causes and guide a more specific treatment plan.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Initiate a targeted developmental protocol for 4 months
 - o Schedule an in-person reevaluation after this period
 - o Establish a developmental baseline and adapt the plan accordingly
- 2. Main Recommended Analysis:
 - EEG (Electroencephalogram)
 - To be conducted by a neurologist
 - Purpose: To detect abnormal brain activity that may be contributing to information processing and developmental delays
- 3. Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:
 - o Mitotherapy Therapy 2 sessions per week
 - **Speech Therapy (ST)** 2 sessions per week
 - o **Occupational Therapy (OT)** − 1 to 2 sessions per week, based on the child's responsiveness and progress
