



## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Shaban Omar Aleshebat was assessed at our center on May 24th, 2025. The assessment revealed the presence of **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. These delays impact the child's ability to understand, respond to, and process stimuli appropriately in real-time settings, affecting cognitive, emotional, and social functioning.

Further medical and neurological analysis is recommended to identify potential underlying causes and guide a more specific treatment plan.

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### Recommended Plan:

- Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
  - Initiate a targeted developmental protocol for **4 months**
  - Schedule an **in-person reevaluation** after this period
  - Establish a developmental baseline and adapt the plan accordingly
- Main Recommended Analysis:**
  - EEG (Electroencephalogram)**
    - To be conducted by a neurologist
    - Purpose: To detect abnormal brain activity that may be contributing to information processing and developmental delays
- Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:**
  - Mitotherapy Therapy** – 2 sessions per week
  - Speech Therapy (ST)** – 2 sessions per week
  - Occupational Therapy (OT)** – 1 to 2 sessions per week, based on the child's responsiveness and progress
