

## **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 14-06-2025

**Child's Name:** Saoud Ahmed Alabdulla

**Date of Birth:** 20-12-2022

### **Overview:**

Saoud Ahmed Alabdulla was brought to our center for a developmental evaluation. The assessment identified **information processing delays** and **speech developmental delays**, which may impact the child's ability to express, comprehend, and process auditory and verbal communication. There are no signs of autism at this stage; however, further investigation is needed to determine the root causes of these delays and support targeted interventions that will help improve cognitive and speech development.

### **Recommended Plan:**

#### **1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:**

- Initiate a structured development protocol for **4 months** to strengthen cognitive and language-related processing.
- Perform an **in-person reassessment** after 4 months to evaluate progress and reset the developmental baseline.
- Continue and adjust the intervention based on the child's developmental response.

#### **2. Recommended Tests (Following Evaluation):**

#### **3. Recommended Therapy:**

- Begin **intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy** immediately to stimulate language centers and processing pathways. Frequency should be **intensive** and adapted based on early response.

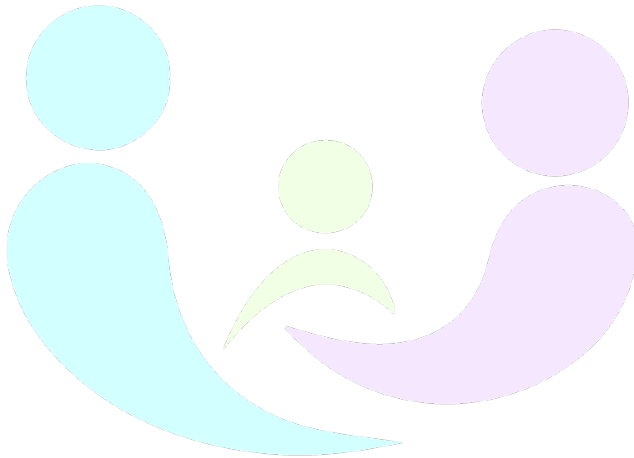
