**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Overview:**

Hamza was assessed at our center on 09-09-2025. The evaluation revealed information processing delays and developmental delays leading to hyperlexia, closer to Hyperlexia Type 3. Importantly, Hamza does not score as a case of autism. He demonstrates significant potential for improvement and development, and is capable of attending a regular school setting with appropriate support. This highlights his readiness for academic inclusion while continuing to strengthen his developmental progress. Further analyses are recommended to gain deeper insights into the underlying biological and cognitive factors.

**Recommended Plan:**

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing**
  - Implement a structured 4-month protocol targeting information processing.
  - Reevaluate after 4 months, preferably in person.
  - Establish a baseline during reevaluation for measurable tracking.
  - Continue with the intervention plan, making adjustments as required.
2. **Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon – Canada):**

3. **Therapy:**
  - Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy: Intensive program, recommended at 2–3 sessions per week, focusing on strengthening cognitive processing, language development, and adaptive functioning.

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**Conclusion:**

Hamza shows strong potential for improvement and readiness for integration into a school setting. His hyperlexia profile is progressing toward Type 3, reflecting both his cognitive strengths and areas requiring support. Intensive therapy combined with recommended external analyses will provide valuable guidance to optimize his developmental trajectory. A reevaluation in 4 months is essential.
