Overview

Mariam Ahmad Abu Khadra visited Ostathna Center – Jordan for a developmental progress assessment.

The evaluation shows that Mariam has improved greatly on the first intervention protocol, demonstrating progress in attention, receptive communication, and adaptive behavior.

At present, she does not meet the criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder or ADHD. Mariam is capable of enrolling in a mainstream classroom environment with continued developmental and therapeutic support.

While her overall progress is encouraging, Mariam continues to present with information-processing delays and general developmental delays, requiring ongoing intervention to strengthen foundational skills and ensure sustained improvement.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the information-processing development protocol for 4 months.
- **Re-evaluate after 4 months**, preferably in person, to establish a new baseline and adjust the plan as needed.
- Maintain **structured home-based follow-up** to reinforce progress achieved in therapy.

2. Recommended Therapy

- **Mitotherapy:** 1 session per week to support cellular energy and optimize neurodevelopmental pathways.
- Speech-Language Therapy & Occupational Therapy: targeted sessions to enhance receptive-expressive language, sensory-motor integration, and school-readiness skills.

Notes on External Testing

If further biomedical insights are desired, the family may consider **specialized external analyses** through **Neurazon** (Canada) such as precision health or neuronal growth factors screening.

These analyses are external services provided through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified international laboratories.

The recommendations are not obligatory and are not conducted directly by Ostathna or EICADD.

Conclusion

Mariam has made **notable gains in her development** and is ready to benefit from a **classroom setting** with continued therapy support.

The proposed 4-month developmental protocol, weekly mitotherapy, and ongoing speech-language/occupational therapy are expected to consolidate her progress and further strengthen her developmental skills.
