

## **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 03-07-2025

**Child's Name:** Kareem Talal Mohamed

**Date of Birth:** 2020-10-29

### **Overview:**

Kareem Talal Mohamed visited our center for a follow-up developmental assessment. The child has shown significant improvement following the first phase of the intervention. However, ongoing signs of information processing delays and developmental delays persist, attributed to genetic variants identified in previous evaluations. These delays have led to acquired features of autism. Continued evaluation and targeted therapy are essential to support Kareem's progress and developmental trajectory.

### **Recommended Plan:**

#### **1. Development Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing:**

- Continue the established non-medicinal developmental intervention protocol.
- Maintain this protocol for 4–6 months.
- Reevaluate the child's progress after this period, preferably through an in-person assessment.
- Establish a new baseline during the next visit to adjust the plan accordingly.

#### **2. Main Recommended Analysis for Next Evaluation:**

#### **○ Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**

- Frequency: 2–3 sessions per week.
- Begin immediately to support ongoing neurodevelopmental recovery.

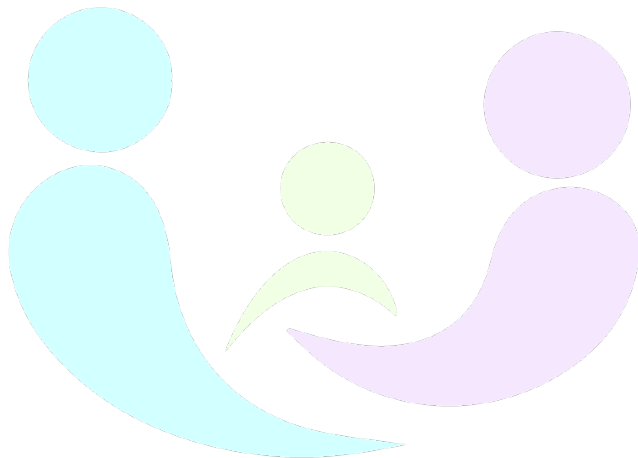
