Overview

Aisha visited our center for a follow-up developmental assessment. The evaluation indicates clear improvement in the first intervention phase. She continues to present with information processing delays and cognitive developmental delays, which have led to acquired autism features.

Previously conducted external genetic and biological analyses through

Neurazon identified variants affecting neurodevelopment, confirming that the underlying cause is biological in nature.

Many of her previous symptoms are improving rapidly, which strongly indicates a high potential for recovery and developmental normalization. The current clinical profile reflects developmental delays rather than true classical autism. However, further assessment remains necessary to continue guiding the intervention plan accurately.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Apply the protocol for **4 months**, followed by a comprehensive reassessment, preferably **in person**.
- Reevaluate the intervention plan and establish a **new developmental baseline**.
- Continue with the current structured intervention program.

2) Main Recommended Analysis (External – Through Neurazon Canada)
