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**Assessment Overview:**

The child was assessed in person at our center. Findings indicate **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays** leading to **acquired features of autism**. These developmental challenges are not necessarily permanent and may improve with early intervention and structured therapy. Further analysis is required to determine the underlying contributing factors.

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**Recommended Plan:**

**1) Development Protocol for Information Processing**

- Implement for **4 months**, followed by reassessment (preferably in person).
- Reevaluate the plan to establish a developmental baseline.
- Continue with the intervention plan as per updated progress.

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**2) Recommended Tests (*through Neurazon – Canada*)**
