

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Mohammad-Ali was assessed at our center on 20-09-2025. The evaluation confirmed a diagnosis of **Joubert syndrome**. During the assessment, he presented with **information processing delays and developmental delays**, attributed to genetic variants affecting brain development. These factors have led to **acquired features of autism**, though he does not meet the full criteria for an autism diagnosis. Additionally, the child demonstrates **learning difficulties** that require early and targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Intensive protocol for **4 months**, followed by reassessment (preferably in person).
- Establish a baseline at the next evaluation and adjust the plan as needed.
- Continue the intervention protocol consistently to support progress.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

(To be repeated once yearly)

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**.

Please note that these are **external, optional tests** and not performed directly at our center.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** – intensive sessions to begin **as soon as possible** to stimulate neuroplasticity, improve cognitive processing, and support motor/learning development.
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Conclusion:

This assessment highlights the child's developmental challenges related to Joubert syndrome and secondary acquired features of autism. The findings are **not a final diagnosis but part of an ongoing developmental evaluation**. Mohammad-Ali is capable of improvement, and outcomes may change with intervention and time.


