
Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Ghena Abdulazeez Al-Garory visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation revealed the presence of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to **hyperlexia features**, positioned between **Hyperlexia Type 2 and Hyperlexia Type 3**. These findings are consistent with **acquired features of high-functioning autism**, though Ghena does **not meet the criteria for a true autism diagnosis**.

Ghena demonstrates advanced recognition and reading tendencies with ongoing challenges in comprehension and interactive communication, reflecting developmental imbalance rather than a neurodevelopmental disorder. The child is **capable of attending a regular school environment** with structured support and consistent therapy. Further analysis is recommended to explore the underlying biological and epigenetic contributors influencing her developmental pattern.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the structured **development protocol** for 4 months, followed by an in-person reassessment.
- Reevaluate progress and establish a new developmental and cognitive baseline.
- Continue implementing the individualized intervention plan.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Rehabilitation Therapy – Plasticity Therapy (Intensive, to start ASAP)**
Focus: enhancing information processing, communication, and adaptive learning skills through neuroplasticity-based intervention.
