### Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Mira was reassessed following her first protocol, where she showed measurable improvement. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays and cognitive developmental delays**, linked to **genetic variants affecting her development**.

According to the **Precision Health Analysis performed**, these developmental challenges are contributing to **features of autism**. However, this is not considered a definitive diagnosis but rather an indication of areas requiring further intervention and analysis.

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### Recommended Plan:

#### 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue with a **structured** protocol aimed at strengthening cognitive processing.
- Duration: 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
- Establish a baseline at reassessment to refine the intervention plan.
- Continue targeted developmental interventions.
