#### Overview

Sidra-Motaz was assessed for developmental functioning. Findings indicate **information processing delays** and broader **developmental delays** that have led to **acquired features of high-functioning autism** with **hyperlexia-like features**. **Further analyses** are recommended to clarify contributing biological factors and to optimize the intervention plan.

#### Recommended Plan

### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a structured protocol for **4 months** (attention, working memory, comprehension, processing speed).
- Reevaluate in person after 4 months to establish a clear baseline and adjust goals.
- Continue and adapt the intervention according to measured progress.

# 2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Canada – Neurazon)

The tests are provided through Neurazon (Canada). They are recommendations, not obligatory, and are not conducted directly through our center.

## 3) Therapy

- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy at 2–3 sessions per week, to start as soon as possible, focusing on processing efficiency, language comprehension, academic skills, and social-communication.
- Parent-guided home routines (15–20 minutes daily) to reinforce attention, sequencing, reading comprehension, and self-regulation strategies.
