

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Omar Abed Darwesh was assessed at our center on May 24th, 2025. The evaluation identified clear **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. These acquired features appear to be the result of underlying neurodevelopmental challenges rather than a primary diagnosis of autism.

Further targeted analysis is necessary to better understand the child's physiological and neurological profile in order to guide a more precise intervention plan. The child was assessed on 24-05-2025 by Ostathna.

Recommended Plan:

- Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Initiate a customized development protocol for a period of **4 months**
 - Conduct an **in-person reevaluation** at the end of this period
 - Use this to reestablish the child's developmental baseline and adjust the plan accordingly
- Main Recommended Analysis (conducted through Neurazon – Canada):**

- Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:**
 - Mitotherapy Therapy** – 1 to 2 sessions per week
 - Speech Therapy (ST)** – 2 sessions per week
 - Occupational Therapy (OT)** – 1 to 2 sessions per week, depending on progress and tolerance


