

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Hussain has **shown significant improvement** since the initiation of the first step of his developmental protocol. He presents with **information processing delays** due to identified **enzymatic and genetic variants**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. It is important to note that these features are a result of **developmental delays** and do not represent a true case of autism. Continued follow-up and further evaluation are necessary to guide the next phase of intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol (Non-Medicinal) for Information Processing**
 - Duration: 4–6 months
 - Reassessment recommended in person afterward
 - Establish a baseline and continue adjusting the intervention plan
2. **Main Recommended Analysis (Following Next Evaluation):**
 - **Please refer to their report and assessment.**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - Continue **Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Special Education Support**
 - **Mitotherapy:** 1–2 sessions per week



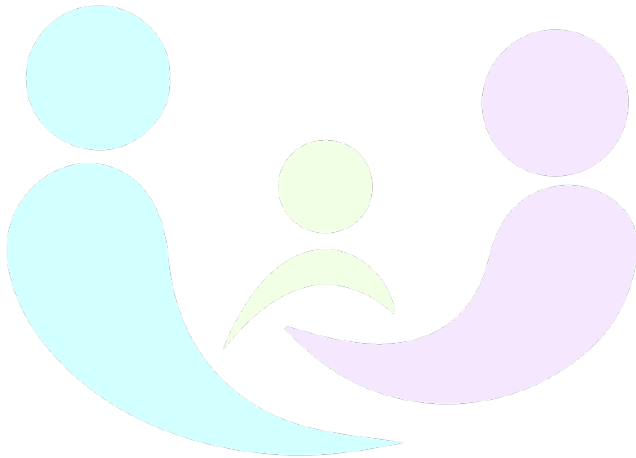
