

## **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 07-07-2025

**Child's Name:** Elmar Khaldoun Dakak

**Date of Birth:** 22-09-2015

### **Overview:**

Elmar Khaldoun Dakak was assessed at our center and presents with information processing delays and regressive developmental delays. These patterns have led to acquired features of high-functioning autism, specifically aligning with characteristics of Hyperlexia Type 2. The features observed are acquired and are not indicative of classical autism but rather a developmental shift due to regression and processing disruptions. Early and consistent intervention is required to guide the child toward improved developmental outcomes and a potential transition toward Hyperlexia Type 3.

### **Recommended Plan:**

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
  - Implement a non-medicinal, structured developmental protocol.
  - Duration: 4 months, followed by an in-person reassessment.
  - Reestablish a developmental baseline to track progress and tailor interventions.
  - Continue the intervention plan after review.
2. **Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):**
  - **Please refer to their assessment and report. These tests are not done at EICADD.**
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
  - **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
    - To be considered in the later stages.
    - Reassessment after 4 months will determine readiness to begin this stage of therapy.

Elmar has the potential for significant improvement, and these findings may evolve with therapy and time. The recommended tests are external and conducted through Neurazon (Canada). 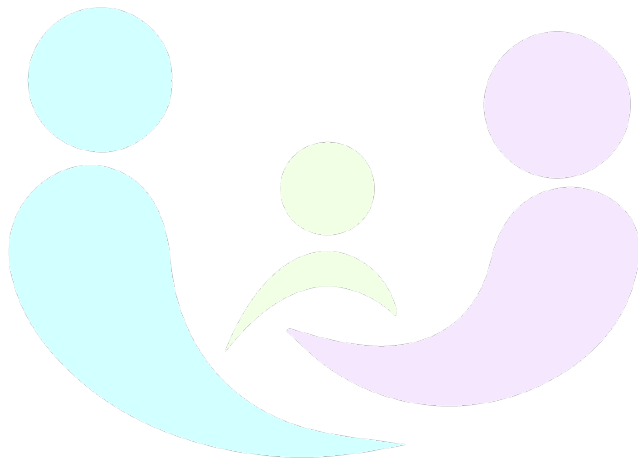
