### Overview

Mohammed Saleh Alzahrani visited Ostathna Center – Jordan for a developmental progress assessment.

The evaluation indicated that Mohammed presents with information-processing delays and global developmental delays leading to intellectual developmental features and autism-related features.

Further **comprehensive analyses are recommended** to clarify contributing factors and to design a targeted intervention plan.

#### **Recommended Plan**

### 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the **development protocol for 4 months**.
- Reevaluate after 4 months, preferably in person, to establish a new baseline and adjust the plan as needed.
- Continue with the intervention plan for sustained developmental progress.











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## 2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada)

• Precision Health Analysis - Neurazon (Canada)

Provides a more detailed analysis of the underlying contributing factors. Sample: Saliva | Turn-around: approximately 4 months (business days).

• Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis - Neurazon (Canada)

Assesses absorption-related factors that may impact brain and body development.

Sample: Hair | Turn-around: approximately 2 months (business days).

Recommended to repeat every 6–12 months.

The recommended tests are conducted externally through Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with certified laboratories worldwide. These are recommendations, not obligatory, and they are not conducted directly through Ostathna Center.

## 3) Recommended Therapy

• Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy – to be considered at a later stage once the child is ready for this intensive therapy.

#### Conclusion

Mohammed will benefit from the **4-month development protocol** followed by a **reevaluation** to adjust his individualized plan.

The external analyses through **Neurazon (Canada)** will help guide the most effective support strategies.

Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy is advised for future stages as readiness improves.
