

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 13-07-2025

Child's Name: Rayan Rafat

Overview:

Rayan was brought to our center for assessment; however, due to limited compliance during the session, a full evaluation could not be completed. A preliminary **consultation-based assessment** was performed, which indicated signs of **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**. These findings are associated with **acquired features of autism**, including **Hyperlexia Type 2** and signs of **Intellectual Developmental Delay**.

Given the child's current profile and the limited engagement during the session, further structured assessment is needed to fully understand the developmental profile and determine the appropriate therapeutic pathway.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Apply for a period of 4 months, then conduct a follow-up assessment (preferably in person)
 - Establish a developmental baseline and track progress
 - Continue with structured developmental activities and parent-guided interventions
2. **Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):**

Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy is not yet recommended at this stage**, as the child is currently not ready for this level of intervention. It will be reconsidered in later stages following developmental stabilization and increased compliance.
