Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Rayan was assessed for developmental, cognitive, and neurological functioning. The assessment indicates information processing delays and global developmental delays, which have resulted in intellectual developmental delays and acquired autism features. Assessed by Ostathna.

Based on today's evaluation, the child scores as a case of Cerebral Palsy (CP), most likely linked to possible early-life hypoxia, although the exact contributing factors require further biological and neurological investigation. The child presents with clear developmental challenges but also demonstrates areas of responsiveness that benefit from structured intervention.

Further analysis—including biological, neurological, and precision-based evaluations—is recommended to better understand the underlying causes and to build a long-term intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the development protocol for **4 months**, followed by an **in-person** reassessment.
- Reevaluate the plan and establish an updated baseline after 4 months.
- Continue the structured intervention consistently.











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2) Recommended Tests Through Neurazon (Canada)

(External analyses; optional; not conducted directly through EICADD Center)

3) Recommended Therapy

• Rehabilitation Therapy — Plasticity Therapy (to begin in later stages when ready). A gradual increase in intensity is recommended based on progress in the next follow-up assessment.

Notes on External Testing



The recommended analyses are performed by Neurazon (Canada), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories.

These tests are external, optional, and not conducted directly through EICADD Center. Parents may proceed depending on their preference for deeper biological insight.

Rayan is capable of improvement, and findings may change with consistent therapy and intervention programs.
