

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Yousef Al Odali was assessed at our center on May 27th, 2025. The assessment revealed that the child exhibits **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**, which have contributed to the emergence of **acquired features of autism**. These features are not the result of classical autism but rather stem from underlying cognitive and neurological inefficiencies. Further diagnostic evaluation is recommended to clarify the causes and tailor a comprehensive therapeutic approach. This assessment was done through Ostathna for education fully.

Recommended Plan:

EICADD

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate a structured intervention protocol for a period of **4 months**
- **Reevaluate the child in person** after the intervention phase
- Establish a clinical and functional baseline to guide ongoing support
- Modify the protocol based on progress and observed needs

2) Main Recommended Analysis (Through Neurazon – Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Mitotherapy Therapy:** 2 sessions per week (LT format)
- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** To be implemented in the UAE during the later stages, once foundational therapies are underway


