

## Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

### Overview:

Ayla Jehad was assessed at our center and presents with **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**. These have resulted in **acquired features of autism**, which may improve with timely and appropriate intervention. Further analysis is needed to determine the root causes and to guide the therapeutic path forward.

### Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing**
  - Duration: 4 months
  - Reevaluate in person after protocol period
  - Establish developmental baseline and adjust plan as needed
- 2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon – Canada):**

### 3. Recommended Therapy:

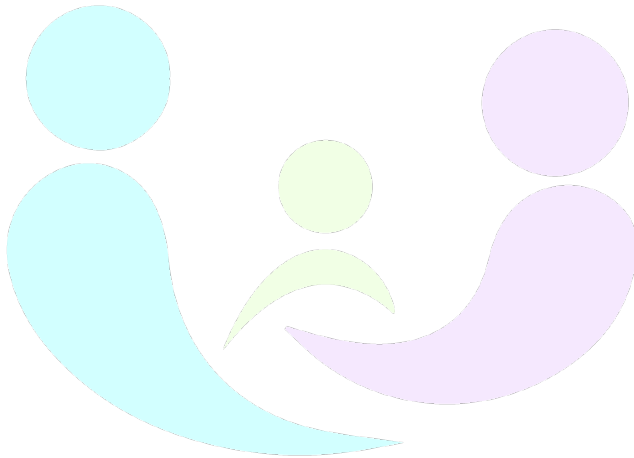
