

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Eva Al Issa was assessed at our center on May 22nd, 2025. The child displays clear signs of **information processing delays** and **intellectual developmental delays**, which have led to **acquired features of autism**. These features do not reflect classic autism, but rather arise from disrupted developmental pathways that can impact communication, comprehension, and adaptive behavior. Further testing is advised to understand the full profile and customize the therapeutic approach accordingly. This assessment is done through Ostathna for Education.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a structured developmental protocol over the next **4 months**
- Reassess the child **in person** after the initial phase
- Use the reassessment to establish a new baseline and adjust the therapy plan accordingly

2) Recommended Tests (Conducted Through Neurazon – Canada):

Please refer to their assessment. *These analyses are conducted externally via Neurazon (Canada) and are not mandatory but are strongly recommended for building a precision-guided treatment plan.*

3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Speech Therapy (ST):** 2 sessions per week
- **Occupational Therapy (OT):** 2 sessions per week

- **Mitotherapy Therapy (LT):** 2 sessions per week, depending on the child's tolerance and readiness


