Assessment Summary:

Shouq Ahmed Alzaubi was assessed for developmental concerns at our center. The evaluation indicates that the child presents with information processing delays and global developmental delays. These challenges have resulted in acquired features that resemble autism; however, it is important to clarify that the child does not meet the diagnostic criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Instead, the findings are consistent with significant developmental delays without a confirmed diagnosis of autism.

Further analysis and targeted interventions are required to better understand and support Shouq's developmental needs.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Initiate a structured developmental program focused on information processing.
- Continue the intervention for **4 months**.
- Reevaluate the child, preferably through an in-person assessment, to establish a more accurate developmental baseline and update the plan accordingly.

2) Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

- Please refer to their report and assessment.

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Therapy (Intensive):**
 - To begin once available either in Jordan or through EICADD UAE.
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy (in Jordan):**
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week of Speech Therapy (ST)
 - Frequency: 2 sessions per week of Occupational Therapy (OT)
- **Mitotherapy:**
 - Recommended frequency: 2 sessions of Light Therapy (LT) per week or intensive sessions if available.


