Assessment Summary:

Ameer was assessed in person and presents with clear signs of **information processing delays**, **developmental delays**, and **acquired features of autism**. While some behaviors overlap with the autism spectrum, the underlying developmental and neurological factors require further exploration. The current presentation does not yet constitute a final diagnosis, and deeper functional analysis is essential.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - o Continue protocol for **4 months**, then conduct a full reassessment (preferably in person)
 - o Monitor progress and establish a response-based baseline
 - Modify the therapy plan according to progress
- 2. Recommended Tests via Neurazon (Canada):
 - Precision Health Analysis
 - Saliva sample
 - Estimated result time: ~4 months business days
 - Aim: Identify underlying causes and contributing factors
 - Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis
 - Hair sample
 - Estimated result time: ~2 months business days
 - Aim: Evaluate nutritional and neurological absorption effectiveness
 - Repeat every 6–12 months as needed
- 3. Recommended Therapy:
 - o Rehabilitation Therapy in the home country (speech, OT, or integrated plan)
 - Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (UAE): Focused on enhancing cognitive processing, neurological signaling, and developmental performance.

Conclusion:

Ameer shows good potential for improvement. This assessment is **not a final diagnosis**, but rather a developmental evaluation. Continued intervention and proper testing are essential to track and support his development. Reassessment is strongly advised after 4 months.
