

## **Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

**Date of Visit:** 11-06-2025

**Child's Name:** Nooh Omer Alkhafaj

**Date of Birth:** 2018-10-19

### **Overview:**

Nooh Omer Alkhafaj visited our center on 11-06-2025 for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation revealed that Nooh has information processing delays, global developmental delays, and learning difficulties. Although minimal features of autism were observed, he does not meet the criteria for an autism diagnosis. Additional analysis is required to fully understand the underlying causes and to develop an effective intervention plan.

### **Recommended Plan:**

#### **1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:**

- Initiate a 4-month structured intervention protocol to address Nooh's information processing and global developmental delays.
- Conduct an in-person reassessment after 4 months to establish a new baseline and refine the plan based on progress.
- Continue with the refined intervention plan to support further development.

#### **2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon, Canada):**

#### **3. Recommended Therapy (post analysis):**

- Begin intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy as soon as possible to address Nooh's information processing and developmental challenges.



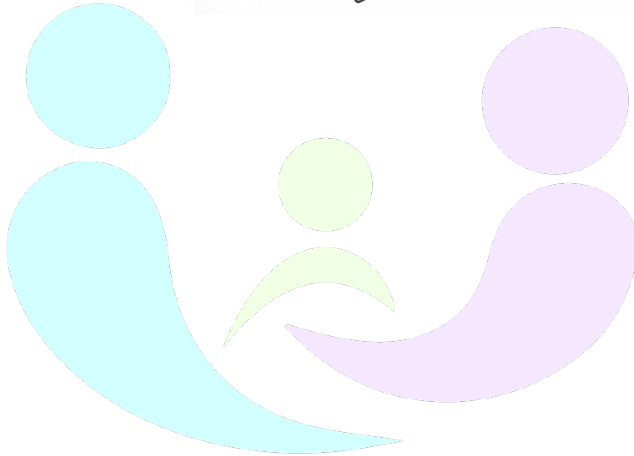
