

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Moustafa Hassan was assessed at our center on March 4th, 2025. The evaluation indicated clear signs of **information processing delays** and broader **developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism**. These traits are closely aligned with **Hyperlexia Type 2**, although the presentation is not fully developed into a classical hyperlexia profile. The child demonstrates advanced decoding abilities with insufficient comprehension and integration of meaning, requiring targeted intervention.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing (Non-Chemical)

- Initiate a structured, non-pharmaceutical protocol focusing on stimulation and cognitive integration for **4 months**
- Conduct a **reassessment after 4 months** to establish a refined clinical baseline
- Monitor progress and adjust the protocol based on observed outcomes
- Continue with therapy sessions and tailored developmental support

2) Recommended Analysis (Conducted Through Neurazon – Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - To begin in **later stages**, ideally **after 2 months** of foundational support and stabilization
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy:**
 - Conducted in the child's **home country** with an emphasis on language integration, sensory processing, and developmental stimulation
