Overview

Meshal-Hamood was assessed in person at our center. The evaluation indicates **information processing delays** and **global developmental delays** leading to **learning disabilities** and **acquired features of autism**. He does **not** score as a case of autism. The child is open to improvement, and **further assessment** is recommended to refine the intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Non-medicinal Protocol for Information Processing

- Apply for 4 months, then reassess in person.
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a clear baseline.
- Continue and adjust the intervention according to progress.

2. Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon, Canada)

- Please refer to their report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.

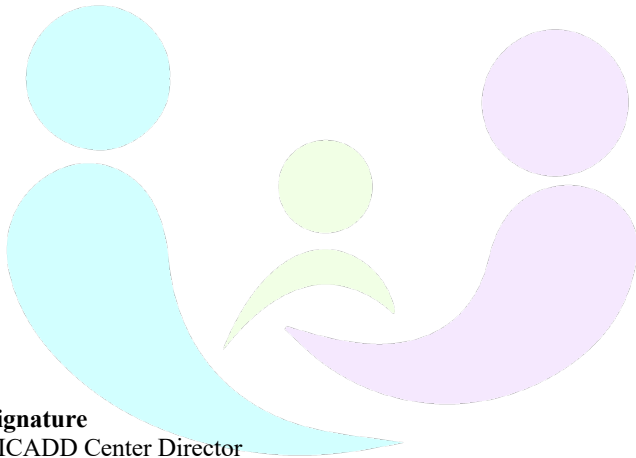
3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy:** intensive program, start as soon as possible.
